

Year 10 Mock Interview Experience - Thursday 28 March

Dear Parents and Carers

In Ready to Learn sessions this half-term, our students in Year 10 have been focussing on developing their interview technique, and learning how to best prepare and present themselves for future interviews.

On Thursday 28 March, their learning will culminate in a Mock Interview Day for all Year 10 students.

Students will be interviewed by local employers; including representatives from the NHS, Merseyside Police, Very Group, Taylor Wimpey, NGF Europe, Barclays and Hays Education.

This is a great opportunity for your child to prepare for the future and it is vital that they attend their interview. Students have been informed of their interview time in Ready to Learn, and this will be communicated to them again this week.

We ask that all parents be supportive in helping their child prepare for this interview.

Students will be asked the following questions:

- **What are your favourite subjects and why?**
- **What experience do you have of working in a team?**
- **What experience do you have of working independently?**
- **Tell me about a time that you have had to overcome a problem.**

Students will then have the opportunity to ask a question to the interviewer. Students have the option of choosing their own question; however, some suggestions are below:

- **What advice do you have for a young person starting their career journey?**
- **What is important to the company you're with, when hiring new people?**
- **What did your education journey include?**
- **How does your first job compare to the role that you have now?**
- **Did you attend university? Why did you make that decision?**

We hope that the students will benefit from this opportunity and thank you again for your continued support.
