## YEAR 8 FOOTBALL

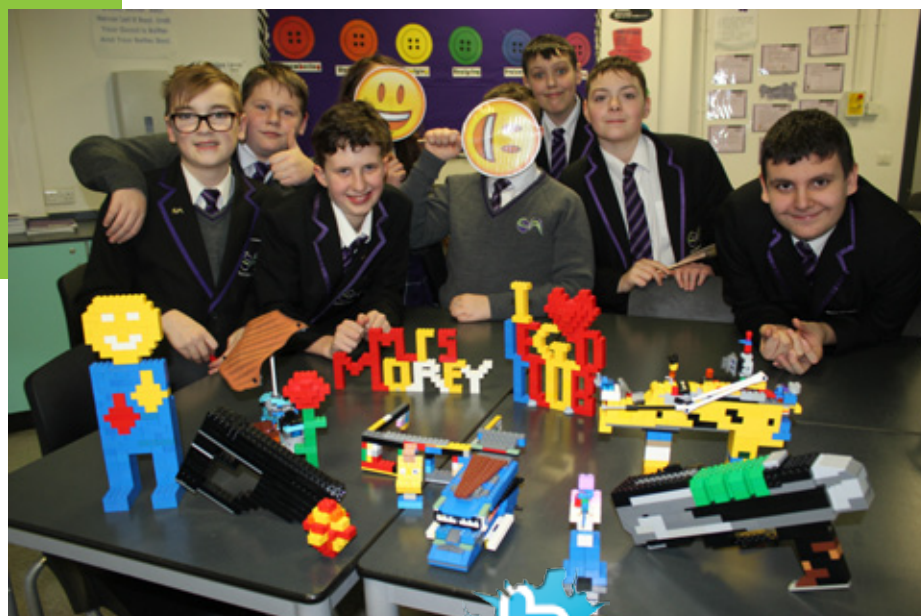
