Trips and Events

We have 'reset the clock' for all students in Year 11 to be eligible to attend our annual prom event on Thursday 19th June 2024 at the Suites Hotel in Knowsley. This means that currently all students are eligible to attend prom. In order to maintain eligibility, students must have from Monday 13th January 2025:

- 95% attendance to school
- No more than 40 behaviour points
- 95% attendance to all Boost and Secure
- Attend all internal and external exams.
- No incidents of a serious nature.
