

Dear Parent/ Carer

We are incredibly proud of our students in year 13; they have consistently demonstrated a conscientious attitude towards their A-Level studies since returning in September. In just a few weeks, your child will be sitting their first round of A-Level mock examinations in all of their subjects. This is a crucial moment for our students in Year 13, as it is an opportunity for them to experience the examination period ahead of their final A-Level examinations next summer. It is therefore important, that we ensure the mock examinations mirror the final examinations as much as possible.

A-Level Mock Exams – 25 November 2024:

The mock exam period starts week commencing the **25 November 2024** and will run for one week. Mock examinations will take place in exam venues and will be fully invigilated to ensure they are conducted in exam conditions. Your child has received their personalised mock exam timetable and we have attached an electronic copy to this email for parents/carers. To ensure students are fully prepared, we have also scheduled '**warm up sessions**' with their class teacher ahead of every mock exam and this is something we will also do for the final A-Level examinations.

Preparing for Mock Exams:

To ensure every student is fully prepared for the mock exams, they will be provided with a full revision list for every subject at least four weeks before the exams on Class Charts and Teams. Students have been provided with revision resources in lessons and have also been receiving lessons on how best to revise for each subject.

It is important to note that all independent learning tasks set for students to complete during Directed Study, Silent Study and for home learning are all focussed on preparing for these exams. Although attendance to Sixth Form and meeting our expectations daily will mean your child has already started preparing, it is also expected that students should be revising independently at home. Students have been provided with all of the resources and materials required, but please do not hesitate to contact a member of the Sixth Form team if you have concerns.

A-Level Mock Results Day – 13 January 2025:

The assessment information we gather from these exams will be used to create your child's A-Level Mock Results Certificate. This will give them a grade in each subject which they are expected to achieve if they continue to work in the same way in which they are working currently. Students will receive their results certificate during a celebratory assembly on the **Monday 13 January 2025**. Students will also receive information regarding which UCAS offers they would secure with those predicted grades.

This day is an exciting opportunity to recognise and reward those students who have worked hard for their mock exams and we will celebrate their efforts and achievements on our social media platforms.

We are very proud of the support we offer our Year 13 students and are confident we can provide your child with the opportunities and encouragement they need to reach their full potential. We hope we can work in strong partnership with parents to achieve this.
