Dear Parent and Student,

Tracking 1 Assessments – Week Commencing 21st October 2024

This half term student first name will be sitting assessments to inform Tracking 1 for this academic year. These will be taking place during the week commencing Monday 21st October 2024. These tracking assessments will be taking place in classrooms during lessons. Teachers will inform students of the day and period each assessment will take place.

The purpose of these assessments is to inform Tracking 1 and to identify what student first name does and doesn't know, so that any gaps in knowledge and misconceptions can be any addressed. For any subjects where students are grouped based on ability, these assessments will also be used to ensure student first name is in the appropriate class.

We expect all students to prepare for these assessments so that they are a positive experience. This week, student first name, has been issued with a Tracking 1 Revision Booklet which contains all the information they need to do well. This booklet contains revision lists for each subject along with associated resources such as knowledge organisers. If student first name misplaces their booklet, they will be able to access this electronically on the school website (Insert Link). It is also important to note, that all home learning tasks set in the lead up to assessments are revision-based tasks, so it is especially important that student first name completes all home learning tasks promptly.

All students in Y7 are eligible to be nominated for the **Revision Revolution** challenge. If they bring in examples of independent revision they have completed and show any member of staff, they will receive a nomination. They will be awarded <u>10+ Achievement Points</u> on Class Charts. The high value tariff attached to this reward, reflects the value we place on revision and independent learning at the Academy. Within each year 7, there will be a voucher awarded to the student who has received the most nominations.

We are proud of the work we do at the Academy to support students during their assessments and hope that we can work in strong partnership with parents/carers to secure the very best outcomes for student first name, If you have any further questions about the upcoming assessments please do not hesitate to get in touch.
